Maintenance Policy

At Kalista we firmly understand the need for all vehicles, plant and equipment (including PPE) to undergo the correct maintenance and inspection routine. This helps to ensure that items function correctly and reduces the likelihood of accidents and incidents.

Each item under the management of Kalista must follow legal requirements and manufacturers guidelines for maintenance and inspections. This is particularly important when overseeing vehicles and plant as they are made up of a wide variety of supporting components; one not working correctly can bring stresses and safety risks on another part or area of a machine.

We recognize that each item needs to be managed differently on a day-to-day basis depending on the function it plays within the business. For instance all vehicles and plant have daily documented check sheets and periodic service schedules based on a weekly, hourly or monthly basis, whereas other items may be visually checked for function and safety on a daily basis. Records of inspection and maintenance are stored on a central company database.

Kalista base their operations on planned maintenance philosophy whereby all employees and management are responsible for the care and upkeep of vehicles, plant and equipment. This helps to ensure a safe and sustainable business which is able to meet the needs and requirements of its customers and clients.
